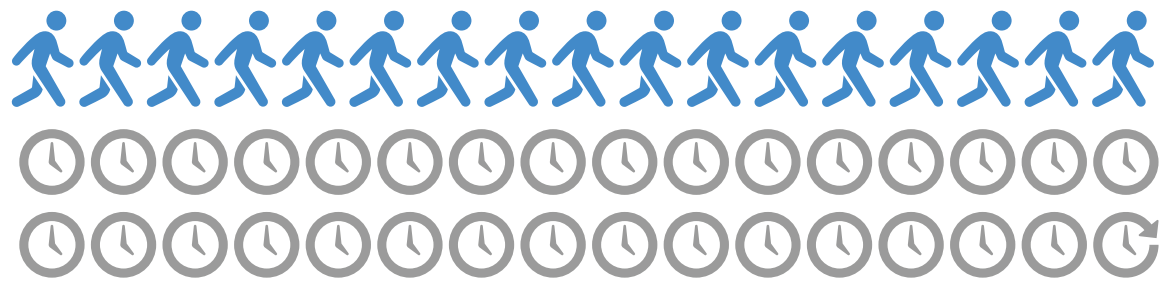

**Completed** our seventh mile of the Spanish Moss trail in Beaufort South Carolina

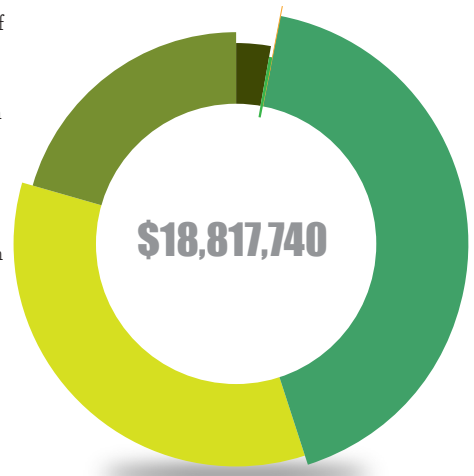

**7** Authored master plans for seven jurisdictions to foster trail development in communities outside of Atlanta

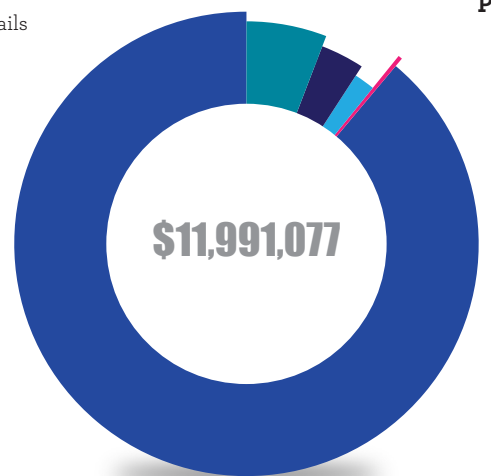
